Company Update

Our construction crew is plowing fiber on Philothea Road between Burrville and Township Line Roads. This section of fiber will serve the homes in this area as well as connect our south fiber ring. CTS Construction from Cincinnati has been working on the remainder of the south fiber ring along State Route 118 between Buschor Road and State Route 29. Once complete the fiber ring will provide redundancy for Fort Recovery and Coldwater in the event of a fiber cut. The fiber ring will be a great asset to our network for reliability and the quality of the services we provide.

In the coming weeks we will be setting our equipment hut in the Village of Rockford. Once the hut is in place we'll continue our network configurations, engineering and construction.

We recently upgraded our equipment on the Neptune Wireless tower along with the backhaul network to better serve the customers in this area. All of our wireless towers now have upgraded backhaul networks to improve our service. Our technicians are now working on upgrading the equipment on our Bryant, Indiana tower to improve coverage and bandwidth delivery.

We have recently added Fox Sports Ohio Alternate HD on channel 149. MLB HD was added on Channel 189. Several channels have been added to watchtveverywhere.com.
